A	3/8 to 1/2 yard white	Diamond strips	Cut 4 strips, 3" x 42". Subcut 1 strip, creating 1 strip, 3" x 11"
B	3/8 to 1/2 yard light gray	Diamond strips	Cut 6 strips, 2" x 42". Subcut 1 strip into 1-2" x 22" and 1-2" x 11"
C	3/8 to 1/2 yard medium gray (1/2 yd. + for qtr. diamond)	Diamond strips	Cut 3 strips, 3" x 42"
D	3/8 to 1/2 yard dark charcoal gray	Diamond strips	Cut 4 strips, 3" x 42". Subcut 1 strip, creating 1 strip, 3" x 11"
E	3/8 to 1/2 yard black	Diamond strips	Cut 3 strips, 3" x 42". Subcut 1 strip, creating 1 strip, 3" x 11" and 1 strip, 3" x 22"
F	1 1/4 to 1 3/4 yards gold	Quarter diamonds, half diamonds, or diamond strips	Cut 1 strip, 2" x 42" Cut 4 strips, 4" x 42". sub-cut 1 4" x 42" strip into 1 4" x 22" strip, and 2 4" x 11" strips
		Outer border	Cut 3 strips, 3-1/2" x 42" Sew end-to-end, creating long borders.
		Binding	Cut 3 strips, 2-3/4" x 42" (or adequate fabric to total 104" long, straight grain or bias)
G	1 1/2 to 1 3/4 yard olive green	Quarter diamonds, half diamonds, or diamond strips	Cut 5 strips, 4" x 42". Subcut 1 strip, into 1 strip, 4" x 22" and 2 strips, 4" x 11".
		Outer border	Cut 3 strips, 3-1/2" x 42" Sew end-to-end, creating long borders.
		Binding	Cut 3 strips, 2-3/4" x 42" (or adequate fabric to total 104" long, straight grain or bias)
H	1/4 yard each of 2 different greens	Diamond strips	Cut 6 strips, 2" x 42". Subcut 1 strip into 2" x 22"
I	1/2 yard total of medium-value yellow-orange, orange, and red-orange fabrics	Diamond strips	Cut 5 strips, 2" x 42". Subcut 1 strip, creating 1 strip, 2" x 22"
J	1/2 yard total of 3 to 6 brown fabrics	Diamond strips	Cut 6 strips, 2" x 42". Subcut 1 strip into 1-2" x 22" and 1-2" x 11"
